Sit-a-thon

Sit-a-thon is a community challenge and peer-to-peer fundraising campaign that raises funds for <u>Pine's Bursary Fund</u>.

Sitters of all ages are asked to do a Sit-Spot alone, with friends, or as a family, to spend time in nature and raise money for kids in nature! The official sit date for Sit-a-thon 2024 is June 23rd, but sitters are welcome to sit any time in June. Every dollar raised supports kids from lower-income families to attend our nature connection programs.

Over the past three years, we've nearly tripled the number of bursaries we award to meet increasing requests from families and reach more children within our broader community.

In 2024, we're aiming to provide 100 kids with a Pine Bursary, but we still need to raise \$30,000 to reach that goal. A Sit-a-thon Sponsorship would drastically improve our efforts. The sponsorship levels below outline the marketing benefits of becoming a sponsor.

Every year, hundreds of families request various levels of support to access Pine programs. Without this support, their kids might not experience vital nature connection.

All kids should have opportunities to play, learn, and grow in nature, regardless of their family's financial situation.

What is a Sit Spot?

A Sit Spot is finding a place in the wild to be still and observe, to sit and expand our awareness. Sitting quietly in nature gives us a chance to slow our pace and to delight in the beauty of nature with our impact reduced. Often, we will have our best wildlife viewing opportunities during sit spot time. It also allows us to practice patience, quietness and reflection.
